

Ashes from Palms for Ash Wednesday

The tradition for Ash Wednesday is to burn the palm leaves from the previous year's Palm Sunday. During this time of Pandemic, we are going to continue that tradition and burn the palms for ashes. For this reason, we like to ask each one of you to bring to the church your old palms to burn them for ashes and use it for Ash Wednesday on February 17th.



Ashes will still be distributed, as long as there is no direct contact. In much of the world, the normal way of distributing ashes on Ash Wednesday is to sprinkle ashes on top of the head, with no contact, rather than smearing them on the forehead. This year we will sprinkle the ashes on top of the head.

Your own internal disposition and intention to repent and start over is the best fruit of Ash Wednesday; the ashes are an external sign of that internal reality.

Let us all enter into Lent with a repentant heart.

Cenizas de palmas para el Miércoles de Ceniza

La tradición del Miércoles de Ceniza es quemar las hojas de palma del Domingo de Ramos del año anterior. Durante este tiempo de pandemia, vamos a seguir la tradición y quemar las palmas para cenizas. Por esta razón, les queremos pedir a cada uno de ustedes que traigan a la iglesia sus palmas de otros años para quemarlas, hacerla cenizas y usarlas para el Miércoles de Ceniza el que será el 17 de febrero.

Las cenizas se seguirán distribuyendo, siempre que no haya contacto directo. En gran parte del mundo, la forma normal de distribuir las cenizas el Miércoles de Ceniza es esparciéndolas sobre la cabeza, sin contacto, en lugar de untarlas en la frente. Este año rociaremos las cenizas sobre la cabeza.

Tu propia disposición interna e intención de arrepentirte y empezar de nuevo es el mejor fruto del Miércoles de Ceniza; las cenizas son un signo externo de esa realidad interna.

Entremos todos a la Cuaresma con un corazón arrepentido.

Del Padre Carlos

Villena, España. 2 de Febrero de 2021.

Hola, queridos hermanos y hermanas!

Les escribo estas líneas desde mi casa en España. Como saben, tuve que salir de emergencia al escuchar que mi madre se había puesto muy enferma. Después de Navidad se contagió con el coronavirus y aunque había pasado unos diez días con síntomas leves, de repente su salud empeoró rápidamente debido a una neumonía aguda que estaba comenzando a aparecer. Gracias a Dios ingresó inmediatamente en el hospital y los médicos pudieron tratar la neumonía con antibióticos. Yo pude verla en el hospital, y tuve la suerte de poder celebrar una eucaristía en su habitación y darle la unción de enfermos. Ese mismo día empezó a sentirse mucho mejor, y los médicos nos dieron la buena noticia que habían contenido la neumonía. Al día siguiente le dieron el alta médica y la mandaron a casa. Desde el Lunes 25 estuve confinado con ella en mi casa y ya no tuvo fiebre ni ninguna otra molestia grave. Solo que está súper débil, y cansadísima, como si le hubiera pasado un camión por encima. Necesitará varias semanas para recuperar las fuerzas.

Para mí ha sido una experiencia muy intensa. El Señor me ha dado la posibilidad de ayudarla y servirla en casa, rezando con ella, diciendo misa todos los días, cocinando para ella... ha sido un tiempo especial.

Mi familia y yo estamos muy agradecidos por todas las muestras de cariño y de apoyo que hemos recibido de todos ustedes, en especial por todas sus oraciones y por las misas que han ofrecido. Ha sido un momento de mucha comunión espiritual que nos ha sostenido cuando estábamos más necesitados. Creo que ha sido un verdadero milagro que una mujer de 78 años, asmática crónica, con presión arterial alta y médica mente inmunodeprimida, haya podido salir adelante. Oremos por todos los hermanos y hermanas nuestros, familiares y amigos, que no han podido superar esta enfermedad. En especial quiero recordar a los padres de nuestro querido hermano sacerdote, el Padre Miguel Ángel Bravo, que han pasado al Padre eterno en prácticamente un mes. Ojalá que la Cuaresma que estamos a punto de comenzar nos ayude a producir frutos de conversión para estar agradecidos por el maravilloso don de la vida y de la fe.

Nos veremos pronto si Dios quiere.



From Fr. Carlos

Villena, Spain. February 2, 2021.

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters!

I am writing these lines to you from my home in Spain. As you all know, I had to leave in a hurry when I heard that my mother had become very ill. After Christmas she was infected with the coronavirus and although she had spent about ten days with mild symptoms, suddenly her health deteriorated rapidly due to an acute pneumonia that was beginning to appear. Thank God she was immediately admitted to the hospital and the doctors were able to treat the pneumonia with antibiotics. I was able to see her in the hospital, and we were fortunate to celebrate a Eucharist in her room and give her the anointing of the sick. That same day she began to feel much better, and the doctors gave us the good news that they had contained the pneumonia. The next day she was discharged from the hospital and sent home. Since Monday the 25th I was confined with her in my house and she no longer had a fever or any other serious discomfort. However, she is super weak, and very tired, as if she would have been hit by a cargo train. She will need several weeks to regain her strength.

For me it has been a very intense experience. The Lord has given me the opportunity to help her and serve her at her home, praying with her, saying mass every day, cooking for her ... it has been a special time.

My family and I are very grateful for all the expressions of love and support that we have received from all of you, especially for your prayers and for the Masses that you have offered. It has been a time of great spiritual communion that has sustained us when we were most in need. I think it was a true miracle that a 78-year-old woman, chronically asthmatic, with high blood pressure and medically immunosuppressed, was able to get by. Let us pray for all our brothers and sisters, family and friends, who have not been able to overcome this illness. I especially want to remember the parents of our dear brother priest, Father Miguel Ángel Bravo, who have passed to the Eternal Father in practically a month. May the season of Lent that we are about to begin help us to produce fruits of conversion to be grateful for the wonderful gift of life and faith.

I will see you soon, God willing.





On the Road to Sainthood – Camino a la Santidad



Sister Thea Bowman

Sr. Thea Bowman, FSPA was a self-proclaimed, “old folks’ child.” Bowman was the only child born to middle-aged parents, Dr. Theon Bowman, a physician, and Mary Esther Bowman, a teacher. At birth, she was given the name Bertha Elizabeth Bowman. She was born in 1937 and reared in Canton, Mississippi. As a child, she converted to Catholicism through the inspiration of the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration and the Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity who were her teachers and pastors at Holy Child Jesus Church and School in Canton. During her short lifetime, many people considered her a religious sister undeniably close to God and who lovingly invited others to encounter the presence of God in their lives. She is acclaimed as a “holy woman” in the hearts of those who knew and loved her and continue to seek her intercession for guidance and healing.

La Hna. Thea Bowman, FSPA era una autoproclamada, "hija de ancianos". Bowman fue la única hija de padres de mediana edad, del Dr. Theon Bowman, médico, y Mary Esther Bowman, maestra. Al nacer, recibió el nombre de Bertha Elizabeth Bowman. Nació en el 1937 y se crió en Canton, Mississippi. De niña, se convirtió al catolicismo a través de la

inspiración de las Hermanas Franciscanas de la Adoración Perpetua y las Siervas Misioneras de la Santísima Trinidad, quienes fueron sus maestras y pastores en la Iglesia y Escuela del Santo Niño Jesús en Cantón. Durante su corta vida, muchas personas la consideraron una hermana religiosa innegablemente cercana a Dios y que invitó amorosamente a otros a encontrar la presencia de Dios en sus vidas. Ella es aclamada como una “mujer santa” en los corazones de quienes la conocieron y amaron y continúan buscando su intercesión para recibir guía y sanación.



Venerable Henriette Delille

Venerable Henriette Delille was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, where she would live her entire life. For the love of Jesus and responding to the Gospel's mandate, she was determined to help those in need. Henriette was also a person who suffered as she made her way through life, and she bore many crosses. She taught those around her that sanctity can be attained in following the path of Jesus. It was in this manner that she dealt with her troubles and major obstacles to achieve her goals. Some of the troubles Henriette met were the resistance of the ruling population to the idea of a black religious congregation; the lack of finances to do the work; the taunts and disbelief of people in her mission; the lack of support from both the Church and civil authority; and poor health. However,

Henriette practiced heroic virtue. She had faith, lived in hope, and practiced love. She was compassionate, forgiving, and merciful. She believed in justice and was not afraid to do what was right in the eyes of God. God blessed her efforts and, in 1842, she founded the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family. Henriette died 20 years later on November 17, 1862. Her funeral was held at St. Augustine Church. Her obituary stated, “... Miss Henriette Delille had for long years consecrated herself totally to God without reservation to the instruction of the ignorant and principally to the slave.”

Venerable Henriette Delille nació en Nueva Orleans, Luisiana, donde viviría toda su vida. Por amor a Jesús y respondiendo al mandato del Evangelio, estaba decidida a ayudar a los necesitados. Henriette también fue una persona que sufrió mientras se abría paso por la vida y llevó muchas cruces. Ella les enseñó a los que la rodeaban que la santidad se puede alcanzar siguiendo el camino de Jesús. Fue de esta manera que lidió con sus problemas y principales obstáculos para lograr sus objetivos. Algunos de los problemas que enfrentó Henriette fueron la resistencia de la población gobernante a la idea de una congregación religiosa negra; la falta de fondos para hacer el trabajo; las burlas y la incredulidad de la gente en su misión; la falta de apoyo tanto de la Iglesia como de la autoridad civil; y mala salud. Sin embargo, Henriette practicó la virtud heroica. Tenía fe, vivía con esperanza y practicaba el amor. Ella fue compasiva, perdonadora y misericordiosa. Creía en la justicia y no tenía miedo de hacer lo que era correcto a los ojos de Dios. Dios bendijo sus esfuerzos y, en 1842, fundó la Congregación de las Hermanas de la Sagrada Familia. Henriette murió 20 años después, el 17 de noviembre de 1862. Su funeral se llevó a cabo en la Iglesia de San Agustín. Su obituario decía: “... La señorita Henriette Delille se había consagrado durante largos años totalmente a Dios sin reserva a la instrucción del ignorante y principalmente del esclavo”.





ST. MARY'S CEMETERY

St Mary's Cemetery in Needham, founded in the 1870's, is the parish cemetery of Mary Immaculate of Lourdes. The Cemetery is a reverent resting place for those awaiting reunion with the Risen Lord. 


